SLO #1. *Students will demonstrate the knowledge of complex interrelated variables which impact the acutely ill patient, and be able to identify appropriate nursing care for this patient.*

SLO #2. Students will demonstrate increasing skills by providing nursing for up to three patients.

SLO for NS 202

The student will examine simulated patient situations involving unmet physiological needs resulting from specified medical-surgical/pharmacologic/mental health problems:

- a. Analyze a presenting clinical situation/scenario from a nursing perspective.
- b. Identify applicable theoretical content from coursework.
- c. Formulate an appropriate course of action for the nurse.
- d. Discuss proposed courses of action within an assigned workgroup.
- e. Participate in the group's decision and selection of the most appropriate course of action.
- f. Assist in the group's presentation to the class regarding the scenario and nursing decisions.
