Northridge (CSUN)	<u>My Northridge Portal</u> . From homepage click skip to portal.	No Deposit Required but need to file <u>intent to Register online by July 1st</u> . Login to portal, go to my checklist, status section and click the "Intent to Register"	1st transcripts send in after Fall and Winter grades are posted and you are enrolled in Spring courses. 2nd transcripts postmark or take in person to CSUN admissions by Aug. 21.	New Student Orientation for transfer students is July 29th. Register on csun.edu/nso . Pay \$35 fee after attendance on your portal under account information and financial obligation. Orientation is not mandatory for transfer students. Registration will begin in June.	You can register for the UDWPE online at www.csun.edu/testing/ click on register for test. March 6th is the deadline for the first scheduled exam. Have your CSUN user ID, password, campus email address, and a VISA/MasterCard or checking account number ready to pay a fee. Print out ticket when finished registering. You can find information about UDWPE at http://www.csun.edu/udwpe/ Register for the exam and attend 1 day class for preparation through the learning resource center. Hold is placed after 75 units if test isn't completed/passed.
Long Beach (CSULB)	<u>My CSULB</u> . From homepage click my CSULB, activate account.	<u>Intent to Enroll and pay \$150 enrollment deposit by June 1st</u> . Login to your account and click Accept/Decline Admission. Need to pay deposit 1st or qualify for waiver to be able to do intend to enroll.	Complete The Supplemental Application January 3rd through February 3rd. This will include fall grades and spring enrolled classes. Final transcripts due in April.	To Register log into your MyCSULB account and click on the SOAR Sign-Up link in MyMenu. Pay fee through your account. Orientation is mandatory.	For registration, workshops, scoring system and more information visit http://www.csulb.edu/divisions/students/testing/wpe/ . The Office at CSULB is located at Brotman Hall (BH), room 216. There is a fee for the WPE. You can sign up by 3/27/15 to take test on 4/18/15. You may also sign up by 6/19/15 to take the test on 7/11/15. Must attempt test 1st sem. or hold will be placed.

You have 2 options. Complete 45 min long transfer overview online at no cost or go to transfer orientation with a \$60 fee. Cal Poly Pomona (CPP)	<u>Bronco Direct</u> . From homepage click bronco direct	No intend to register required but <u>pay \$ 100 Deposit by May 1st</u> . Go to bronco direct to pay.	1st transcripts send in as directed on your Bronco Direct (student account) 2nd transcripts send by July 15 Deadline	Orientation is mandatory. Deadline to register for orientation is June 1st. Register now by Logging in to Bronco Direct, click Register for Orientation, and follow the instructions. \$ 83 fee pay online by July 1st.	Students need to have completed 90 quarter units or 70 semester units to take the GWT. There is a 25\$ non refundable fee for testing. To register login to Bronco Direct. For more information visit http://www.csupomona.edu/~academic/testcenter/test_gwt.shtml If GWT hasn't been completed after 120 quarter units a hold is placed on account.
Dominguez Hills (CSUDH)	<u>My CSUDH</u> . From homepage click my CSUDH, activate your account ? New user	No enrollment deposit required but file for <u>intent to register by May 1st</u> . Login to My CSUDH, click application status link, click accept/decline.	1st transcript send by March 15th and 2nd transcripts by July 15th	Orientation is optional. 87\$ Fee required. Register in April through my CSUDH account. The assigned dates are May 22, May 29, June 11, June 25, July 10, July 24, August 17.	Sign up and get more information for GWE through www.csudh.edu/testing . There is a fee. Workshop dates, handbook and a PowerPoint is provided online through this site for preparation. CSUDH does not put a hold on registration if test isn't completed but GRE needs to be passed in order to graduate.
