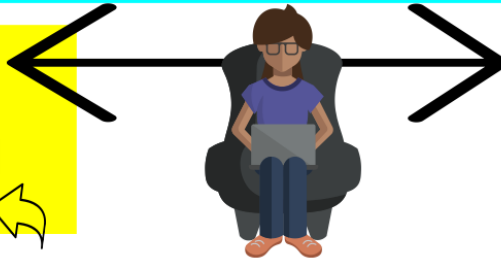


# Spring 2016 Distance Ed Workshops
