After an extensive review process, the ASGCC Finance Committee proposes the following Campus Project Support recommendations for approval. We believe the following funded applications will benefit Glendale Community College students (including Garfield Campus and CDC) in the coming months and year(s).

Application #1: Colleen Pathe (Pg.1)

Idea: Elevator Tower Area Beautification.

Recommendation: Deny.

Reason: Too much wiring that was not being paid for, that had to be done. Not enough planning (speakers price was estimated). Had not been discussed with Facilities, and had risk.

Application #2: Joshua Yukiah Archer (Pg.4)

Idea: Cast, rehearse, and play performance.

Recommendation: Deny.

Reason: No budget list. Application clearly states that all applications must have a budget list.

Application #3: Darren Leaver (Pg.6)

Idea: Pay for the classrooms for the study abroad summer 2015.

Recommendation: Deny.

Reason: School can pay for this. The Students that are going on this study abroad are GCC students that have paid for these courses, airfare, food, etc... This money should not come out of the students pockets a second time, since they have already paid for the courses. Application states that they are in the process of requesting funds from the school, and will receive the funds from the school in a few months.

Application #4: Alfred Ramirez (Pg.7)

Idea: Garfield Campus "Career Education Expo".

Recommendation: Approve. Partial Funding. **(\$1550.00)**

Reason: The funded items actually benefit the students, whereas the advertising material can be funded through the college/district.

Application #5: Amy Sarkisian (Pg.9)

Idea: Artist Lecture Series.

Recommendation: Approve. Partial Funding. **(\$1000.00)**

Reason: Instead of 6 lectures, we reduced it to 3 because we did not think there was that big of an art program at GCC to need 6 lectures.

Application #6: Eric Hanson (Pg.11)

Idea: Charging Stations.

Recommendation: Approve. Partial Funding. **(\$549.95)**

Reason: Most students bring their chargers, and we agreed that one would be enough for the students who don't bring their chargers.

Application #7: Kevin Meza (Pg.12)

Idea: So Cal Tours (UCLA&USC).

Recommendation: Deny.

Reason: Already funded same idea with C.P.S this year.

Application #8: Arin Sadeghi (Pg.13)

Idea: iPad Tablet & Kiosk.

Recommendation: Deny.

Reason: Did not think it was needed. Had no specific purpose.

Application #9: Gavin Hukassian (Pg.17)

Idea: Student Calendar App.

Recommendation: Deny.

Reason: Did not directly benefit GCC students, and had too many liabilities. At the end of the day it's his app, not the schools or the students of the school directly.

Application #10: Grigor Sargsyan (Pg.18)

Idea: Club Bench.

Recommendation: Approve. Full Funding. **(\$403.05)**

Reason: The space needed a bench, and now the students can be a part of that process as well as promote their clubs.

Application #11: Daphne Dionisio (Pg.25)

Idea: EGG Headset Research.

Recommendation: Approve. Full Funding. **(\$1076.74)**

Reason: It will promote a broader spectrum of research for GCC students.

Application #12: Maria Kretzmann (Pg.30)

Idea: Purchase of dissecting microscopes.

Recommendation: Approve. Partial Funding. **(\$1000.00)**

Reason: The requested number of microscopes was 2 however, having 2 microscopes was not a necessity therefore the recommended funding is for 1.

Application #13: Sharyn Absatz (Pg.31)

Idea: iPhone news app for El Vaquero.

Recommendation: Approve. Full Funding. **(\$600.00)**

Reason: It will encourage students to be more involved by knowing about the events and important news about the college.

Application #14: JC Moore (Pg.36)

Idea: GCC Social Movement/ peaceful protest.

Recommendation: Approve. Partial Funding. **(\$880.50)**

Recommendation: Approve. Partial Funding. **(\$1000.00)**
