



Combining Moodle Courses Into One Section (Unavailable for online and hybrid classes)

“All Sections” course shells are provided for faculty who are teaching on-site web enhanced courses (only) that would like to combine their course materials into one Moodle course shell. You will see your courses with a ticket number, (ticket numbers are how PeopleSoft loads students into your Moodle course) and the ones labeled “All sections” with no ticket number (see below). All your students that are enrolled into that course that you are listed as the instructor of record on will also be loaded into the “All Sections” course. This means if you choose to use the “All Sections” Moodle course shell, that your student’s grades will be merged in the “All Sections” course shell gradebook.
