CRIME BULLETIN: "Aggravated Assault Off-Campus"

The following crime bulletin is being sent in compliance with the *Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act*.

Synopsis: On Wednesday, February 22, 2017, an aggravated assault stabbing occurred across the street from the Glendale College Garfield Campus. This incident occurred after the Garfield Campus was closed and in the Family Medicine Center parking lot located at 801 S Chevy Chase Drive, involving three male victims (non-students). There is no information or indication to believe any members of the campus community were targeted.
