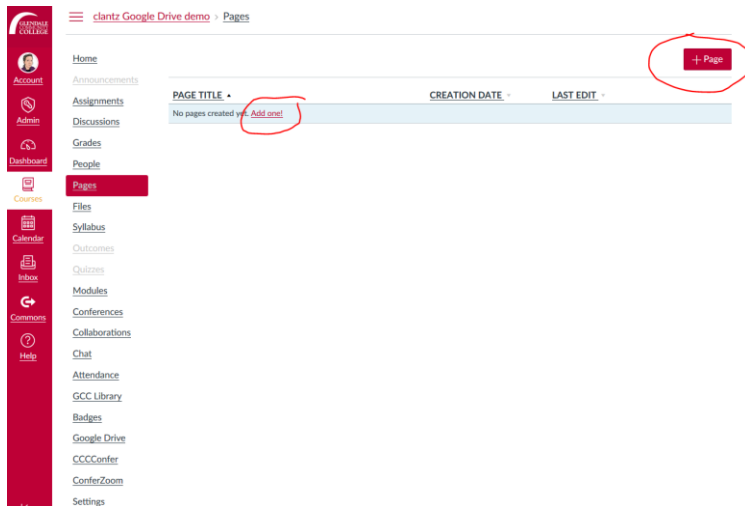
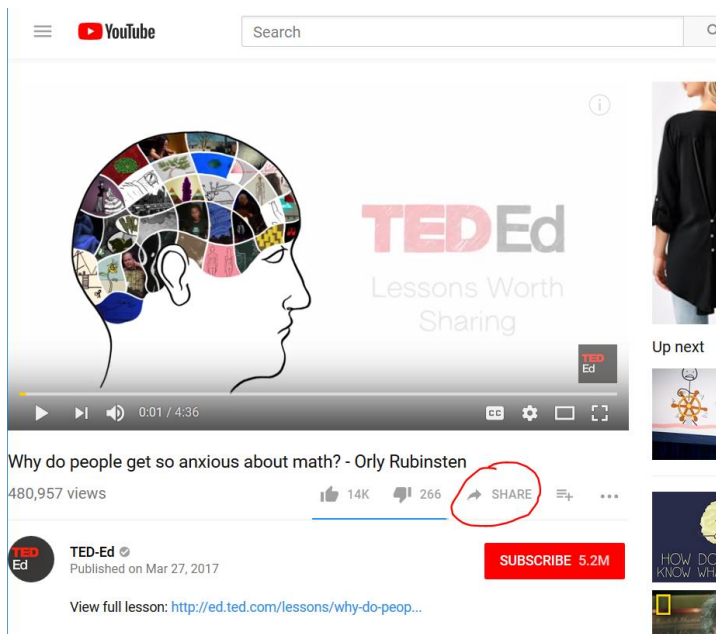


## How to add media to your Canvas course

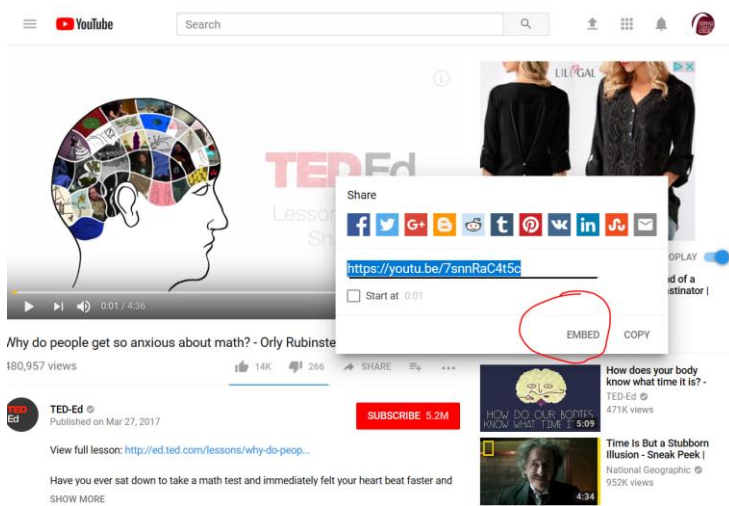
Go into your course, click on the pages section and click on + Page



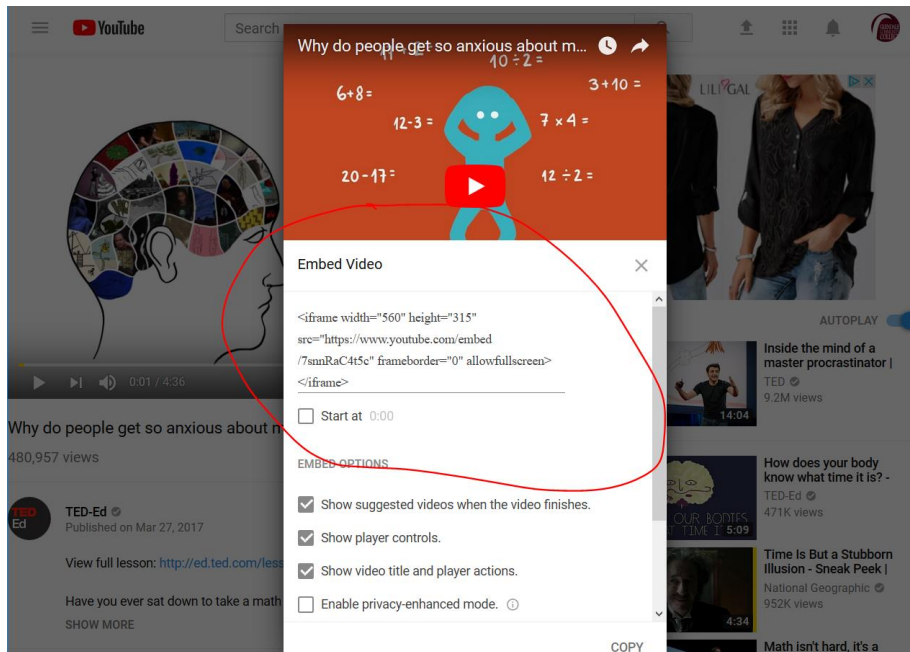
Next, go to where your video is (in this case YouTube) and click on “Share”



Click on the "Embed" option



Copy this embed code



Now, go back to your course, to the added page, and click on “HTML editor”
