

Guided Pathways Work Plan Process

Part of GCC's Guided Pathways Implementation Efforts

Background

In December 2017, GCC completed a self-assessment describing our scales of adoption at the outset of guided pathways implementation of 14 key elements defined by the Chancellor's Office (CO). In March 2018, we submitted a work plan outlining activities we aimed to undertake in an effort to advance our scales of adoption of some of these key elements. This work plan covers the time period from Spring 2018 to Summer 2019. Work Plan Development Process

With support from facilitators at a CO guided pathways workshop on February 20, 2018, a GCC team of attendees parsed out the 14 key elements to several draft authoring teams. The drafts for these 14 key elements were aggregated into a complete work plan, reviewed by GCC's GP Steering Committee, and then sent out college-wide for feedback via a web-form. The final revised version was certified and submitted to the CO prior to the March 31 deadline.

Work Plan Draft Authoring Teams

Authoring teams were selected based on function within the college and expertise needed to address each key element. In some cases existing groups on campus were chosen to write the draft. In other cases, ad hoc groups were created for the purpose of generating a draft. The table below shows the membership of the authoring teams.
