**CRIME BULLETIN: Attempted Robbery (With Force)**

**DATE: 12-04-18**

**Suspect Description:** Male Caucasian or Hispanic, approximately 20 years of age, black hair, purple or blue colored hooded sweater with light colored athletic logo on the back, black baseball cap, grey shorts with black stripes down the seams, grey shoes.

**Synopsis:** On Monday, December, 3, 2018, at around 1:10 p.m. an attempted robbery occurred at the bottom of the pedestrian footbridge ramp next to the Flame Broiler restaurant across from the Verdugo Campus. The suspect approached a GCC student and attempted to forcibly take a purse and back pack. A bystander then intervened and stopped the robbery. The suspect then fled the area on foot traveling north.

**General Prevention Safety Tips:**

- Be alert to your surroundings.
- Cooperate with a suspect's demands; your property can be replaced.
