

NEW STUDENT CHECKLIST FOR 2019

Complete these steps by April 26 to receive priority registration for Fall 2019.

STEP 1 — APPLICATION

- Complete your Application for Admission for the Fall 2019 semester
 - Visit www.glendale.edu/APPLY

STEP 2 — PLACEMENT

- Placement into English and Math classes no longer requires an assessment test. Visit the Assessment Center (SV 3rd Floor) with the following items:
 - Copy of your high school transcripts OR
 - Know your high school GPA and the grade in your last English and Math classes.
 - If you do not have high school records or are a returning student, visit the Assessment Center for guidance.

Do you have an IEP or 504 plan? Take your last IEP or 504 plan to DSPS – Disabled Student Programs and Services (SF 121) for additional assistance and support www.glendale.edu/DSPS

- ESL and Chemistry Assessments can be taken in the Assessment Center
 - Visit www.glendale.edu/Assessment for testing schedule and sample tests

STEP 3 — ORIENTATION & S.E.P.

- New Student Advising Workshop
 - Attend the New Student Advising workshop to complete orientation & meet with a counselor to develop your required Student Education Plan (S.E.P.)
 - Appointments for New Student Advising can be made at the Assessment Center

OR

- Online Orientation & Counseling
 - Complete the online orientation from home & meet with a counselor to develop your required Student Education Plan (S.E.P.)

STEP 4 — REGISTER

- Register for Fall 2019

 - Check your MyGCC for your registration appointment date and time (www.glendale.edu/myGCC)
 - Priority registration starts **May 20**
 - Open registration starts **June 3**

APPLICATION STEPS

Before you begin the application make sure you have:

- An email account
 - Your social security number or a valid TIN (Tax identification Number)
 - Your address and phone number
 - Your educational history, including where you graduated from high school and the last college you attended, and the years you last attended these institutions
 - Know your residency status
- >>If you have a permanent resident card, you will need to know your alien registration number, the issued date and expiration date.
