# IGETC PATHWAY

- ▶ Three year program (10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade)
- ▶ 60 students have been accepted
- ▶ The pathway is built into high school master schedule
- ▶ Students will complete 45 college units in the program
- ▶ Students have the opportunity to complete beyond the 45 units through summer sessions or after-school dual enrollment program
  - ▶ This student could be transfer-ready
  - ▶ This could lead to an AA/AS Transfer degree
- ▶ A-G and high school graduations requirements are still being met

# College Courses

- ▶ Taught by GCC faculty
- ▶ There will be two groups in each cohort (class size: 30 students)
- ▶ Textbooks will be provided
- ▶ Must follow ECA Pathway
- ▶ Course syllabus is students contract with instructor/course
- ▶ Faculty Office Hours will be at Hoover and/or virtually

# STUDENT SUPPORT

- ▶ Built in student development course
- ▶ Students in the program will always have access to the GCC Dual Enrollment Counselor
- ▶ Study-hall built into the program schedule
- ▶ Tutoring support is being developed for on-site
- ▶ All GCC services and programs will be available students (additional tutoring, writing lab, math lab, at GCC)
