The undergraduate program in the Department of Architecture is considered to be "impacted," that is, many more students apply than can be accommodated each year and a supplementary admissions process is required by the University and the Department.

Applications are only accepted from October 1 through November 30 for the following academic year. Non-resident and foreign students are eligible to apply.

Admission for transfer students is primarily based on their college GPA (minimum GPA of 3.2). **The "Golden Four" (Oral Communication, English Composition, Critical Thinking, and Quantitative Reasoning) must be completed by the end of the spring quarter in which the student applies to the program (e.g., by the end of Spring 2016 for entrance in Fall 2016).**

Transfer student applicants are notified of the Department's decision in late March or early April.
