Dear Faculty & Staff:

With the official start of the Fall 2022 semester, we want to thank you for your patience with all the construction across the district. We hope you are as excited as we are to see the Measure GC tax dollars at work beautifying our College campuses!

In the upcoming weeks, the Central Plant 1 project on the Verdugo Campus will require trenching to cross the Circle Drive entrance. In light of this activity, College leadership has determined it is in the best and safest interest of students, faculty, and staff to close nearby on-campus parking lots for nearly five weeks starting **Tuesday, September 6 through Friday, October 7**. The following parking lots will be impacted:

- Lot CD (Circle Drive in front of Administration Building)
- Lot H (Between the Auditorium and San Fernando Complex)
- Lot I (Between Auditorium and N. Verdugo Road)

ADA Parking

Those with ADA parking needs who normally park in Lot CD, H, or I, are advised to temporarily park in Lot C (GCC Parking Structure).

Lots CD, H, and I

We request that all faculty and staff with a parking permit for either Lots CD, H, and I to park in Lot A, Lot C (GCC Parking Structure), or any of the municipal lots (Lots 30-34) across N. Verdugo Road. We encourage a clear display of your parking permit to avoid receiving a citation. The City will honor your GCC parking permit.

Pedestrian Pathway to access N. Verdugo Road

During the period of construction, we will provide a six-foot clear pedestrian path of travel onto campus at the Circle Drive entrance from the Verdugo Rd. bus stop and Verdugo Rd. drop-off area. Appropriate signage will also assist in redirecting vehicular and pedestrian traffic. ***Upper Campus Lot B drop-off during this closure is preferred.*** The main staircase connecting the Administration Building to N. Verdugo Road is tentatively scheduled to reopen on Monday, October 10.
