The following process for reviewing the college mission statement every three years was approved at the November 19, 2021 Team A meeting. (to be revised by Team A on May 5, 2023.)

The college mission, vision, and values statement will be formally reviewed every three years, starting in Fall 2022.

Questions for the review of the college mission, vision, and values statements

Questions for review of the college mission statement

- Does the mission accurately reflect the current character of GCC?
- Does the mission accurately reflect the current values of GCC?
- Has the organizational structure of GCC changed?
- Have the demographics of students served by the college changed?
- Is GCC still engaged in ensuring equitable educational outcomes?
- Has there been a significant change in our strategic priorities?
- Has there been a change in the vision?
- Have the educational/career training needs of our students changed?
- Have state laws changed?

Question for review of the college vision and values statements

- ~~Has there been a significant change in our organizational structure, the manner in which we are working together, or the types of issues we should be addressing?~~
