Greetings Team GCC,

As of writing this, there are significant fires and other serious hazards created by the wind event in the communities surrounding our college. Many employees and students live in these neighborhoods and may be facing evacuations, power outages, or other impactful conditions. Our thoughts are with those affected and we stand ready to support our community members in these situations.

Out of an abundance of caution, all campuses will remain closed for tomorrow, Wednesday January 8, 2025 due to high wind activity until 4:00 p.m. We expect that the winds will have subsided by this time and that all impacted areas will be mitigated allowing us to return to normal operations for evening classes and events.

Supervisors will communicate with employees to organize remote work operations during this period of college closure. Those unable to work remotely will have the opportunity to utilize personal necessity leave. If you have been contacted by your supervisor to be onsite as essential personnel, you will need to come in unless unable to do so.

Please check your GCC email for further updates regarding college operations. Again, we anticipate normal operations by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday January 8th, 2025 and will advise if the circumstances require a change.
