APPLIED FOR FALL 2025 ADMISSION? IT'S TIME TO UPDATE YOUR APPLICATION

In order to ensure that UC and CSU campuses have the most current academic information available, all transfer applicants are required to submit updates to their applications with fall 2024 grades and confirmation/modification of winter/spring 2025 courses.

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA

UC - [Transfer Academic Update \(TAU\)](#)

All transfer applicants must submit a TAU by the **January 31st deadline**, including students who apply in December or early January to one of the five open campuses (see below). You must submit a TAU even if you have no fall 2024 grades or winter/spring 2025 courses to report. Failure to complete the TAU may affect an admission decision, so make sure to complete the TAU prior to the January 31 priority deadline. CSU The California State University

CSU - [Transfer Academic Update](#)

Transfer applicants must update their Cal State Apply application by the **January 31st deadline**. Refer to the [2025-2026 Academic History Update Guide for Transfer Applicants](#) for instructions on how to complete the update.

SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATIONS

Some campuses and programs require submission of a supplemental application in addition to the UC and/or CSU application. Deadlines for supplemental applications and required materials vary but are strictly enforced. Please check with the department and campus for current information.

Some notable schools:

UC BERKELEY: Many majors require the completion of an additional form, which can be found in your campus application portal (MAP@Berkeley) under "Forms."

CSU LONG BEACH: You may be required to submit a [Supplemental Application for Transfer](#), which is an online application that is specific to you, is specific to your intended major, and is specific to CSU Long Beach.

SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY: All applicants for transfer will be required to complete an SJSU-specific Supplemental Application including grades for all coursework completed to meet the requirements for admission for that term. The supplemental application will be assigned in [MySJSU](#) to transfer applicants to collect any additional information required to complete the admission process.

ADDITIONAL STEPS FOR FALL 2025 APPLICANTS

Campus Portals

Campuses you applied to will email you to create a username and password for access to the campuses' applicant portals. These are where admission decisions will be posted along with other important information. You should check each campus portal frequently.

Transcripts

Did a campus request official transcripts from you? You can [order your official transcripts](#) through the Office of Admissions and Records. **Note:** Only Glendale Community College grades are issued. Grades from other schools must be ordered from the original school. The same goes for any AP scores you may have earned. Official score reports must be [ordered from College Board](#).

Note: Many universities rely on the information you reported on your application to make their admission decisions, and may not request transcripts from you unless you're admitted. So, unless they request them from you, do not send transcripts.

Apply for your Associate Degree and GE Certification

If you will be completing your associate degree and/or GE requirements in winter or spring, meet with a counselor to apply for your degree(s) **and** the certificate of achievement in IGETC or CSU GE Breadth (depending on which one you've been completing). The deadline to apply and be included in the graduation program is **May 9, 2025**.

Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) Verification Process

If you indicated on your CSU application that you have earned/will earn the ADT, Glendale Community College will e-verify that you're earning the degree. You have to apply for the degree, however. If you haven't already, make an appointment to speak with a counselor for assistance with applying for the degree. The deadline for GCC to e-verify students is **March 14, 2025**.
