WHAT IS EARLY COLLEGE ACADEMY?

Early College Academy (ECA) at Hoover High School offers an innovative pathway for students to concurrently earn a high school diploma and 44 college units in the time it takes to graduate high school. ECA integrates college classes into the high school bell schedule, allowing students the opportunity to **earn up to 2 years of college courses for FREE** - saving parents and students time *and* money.

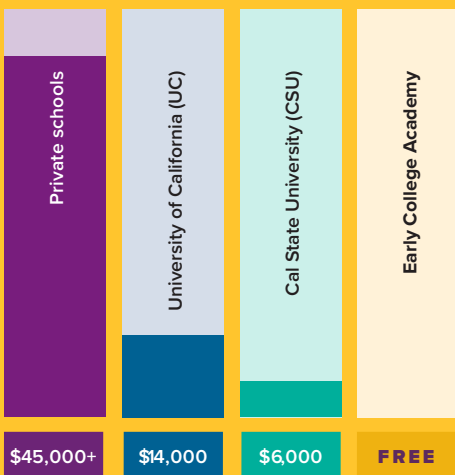

COST

Early College Academy is FREE!

Tuition, fees, course material, and textbook cost waived.



ESTIMATED ANNUAL TUITION (BASED ON FULL-TIME ATTENDANCE)

CONVENIENCE

Earn college credit without ever having to leave the Hoover High School campus

College classes are part of your regular high school schedule

Students build camaraderie with their peers by completing classes together as a cohort

GCC Faculty come to Hoover High School to teach college classes

Access to GCC counseling services & programs available to all ECA students (tutoring, writing and math labs)

Students get a head start on fulfilling their general education requirements (IGETC) for college upon high school graduation

ECA students have the opportunity to complete 1-2 years of college and be:

- »A high school graduate
- »A-G Certified
- »UC/CSU IGETC Certified*
- »Transfer prepared

*Additional coursework may be required if students also plan on completing an associate's degree by the end of the program. Some private and independent colleges/universities may not accept dual credit courses. For more information, please contact individual institutions directly.
