- The committee discussed AR 5020 which is for non-resident tuition.
- Students would become residents if they lived here for more than 1 year in order to get AB 540 benefits.
- This bill is to help people whose parents have been deported.
- Read over Board policy for non-resident tuition with exemption for students whose parents served in the military or if their parents were deported.
- The student health fee is increasing by \$1 and will give us an additional \$24,000 to \$28,000 overall.
