### **XIII. Reports of Governance/Special Committee Meetings**

- **OER - Open Educational Resources**
- **Enrollment Management**
  - Bella began by stating how the committee meeting started on how Dr. Cornner began with his goals for the community and how the buildings on campus and how they need to be filled with faculty.
  - Bella then moved forward with the issue of fraudulent students and how faculty is irritated by these students who enroll in classes and don't show up to what they enrolled in
  - Bella also added on how faculty collect data for the schools use, and how important it is for students to update their major and information while they are enrolled at GCC.
- **Academic Affairs**
  - Chelsea began with how the committee meeting was focused on 8 week classes and how effective they are. As well as how the faculty are aiming for about 20% of these classes to be 8 week courses, which will replace the ones in their place rather than adding new ones entirely.
  - Chelsea then added with how international students are at risk of being sent back to their countries if they are dropped from their courses
  - She then added how they are developing a new branch for the Fire Safety school
  - A new partnership with LMU is in the works
  - Instructional service office has seen new hires and is offering a new language proficiency certificate
- **Student Affairs**
  - GCC AR5220 which are the shower faculty for enrolled homeless students, and new showers were added to the Garfield campus, which had their hours adjusted
  - There was also a request for a new map to easily access these showers
- **Scholars Program**
  - Katya began with how the meeting began with general information as to what the requirements were and how they slightly changed the constitution with the credit requirements went from 10 to 11 due to a new credit in the Arts and Culture committee to increase participation
  - Dr. Harnett also spoke about blanket courses and how they will no longer be offered for the scholars program, but will be rebranded as an official honors class which will be available to all students, not just Scholars students
  - Natalie then added that the Scholars program is having a fundraiser at Wild Acai and an arts and culture event from 5:30 - 7:30
  - Priority registration will start on October 30th for the Winter
- **Board of Trustees**
  - Nathan brought up how there was a discussion to change one of the main functioning systems for GCC faculty, but the change was denied because GCC was stated to have one of the best systems out of all the schools
  - The budget act of 2025 demonstrates an increase in budgets for all community colleges

**XVIII. Announcements/Information**


- Nathan emphasized how important it is that the senators participate in their meetings, not only is attentiveness important, but participation as well
